the career mentoring programme for high-potential female students and junior researchers at the Faculty of Engineering and the Faculty of Sciences.

Mentoring is a particularly proven and effective human resources development tool in which a person with career experience (mentor) advises a young scientist or student (mentee) individually on strategic and practical questions of academic career planning.

The free offer is aimed at female students and doctoral candidates who are interested in further academic qualification, as well as post-doctoral researchers, Habilitandinnen and W1 professors.

As a supplement to academic supervision, **ARIADNE** provides **interdisciplinary mentoring**. This offers space for an open and trusting exchange with an independent and neutral person on individual questions of career crafting in science.

ARIADNE TechNat offers

- individual one-to-one counselling by an experienced scientist of a higher qualification level
- career workshops
- expansion of your peer network

Qualification specific programmes

ARIADNE TechNat master

- Mentoring for female students* of the Faculty of Engineering and the Faculty of Sciences who wish to pursue a doctorate
*Master's degree or state examination
- Duration: 9 months
- Workshop programme with focus on *Presentation & Networking* and networking events

ARIADNE TechNat doc/postdoc+

- Mentoring for female doctoral candidates, post-doctoral researchers, Habilitandinnen and W1 professors of the Faculty of Engineering and the Faculty of Sciences
- Duration: 18 months
- Workshop programme with focus on *Career Crafting, Leadership Skills, Presentation & Networking, Third-party Funding, Resource Management* and networking events
- Postdoc+ workshop on *Appointment Procedures for Professorships*
