FAUmentoring ARIADNE rewi is

the career mentoring program for high-potential female early career researchers at the Faculty of Business, Economics, and Law.

Mentoring is a particularly proven and effective personnel development tool in which an experienced researcher (mentor), provides guidance and advice in strategic and practical questions concerning an academic career to an early career researcher (mentee).

The program is free of charge and is ideal for female early career researchers who are interested in pursuing an academic career and would like to further develop their personal skills. The program runs for one and a half years.

Complementary to academic supervision, **ARIADNE provides interdisciplinary mentoring**. This offers space for an open and trusting exchange with an independent person on individual questions relating to career planning in academia.

FAUmentoring ARIADNE rewi offers

- Individual mentoring support from experienced researchers from higher qualification levels
- A framework program consisting of an official kick-off and closing event and workshops at the beginning, in the middle and at the end of the mentoring program
- Networking meetings to expand your peer network

FAUmentoring ARIADNE rewi is part of the faculty-specific target agreements for increasing the proportion of women in academia.



Mentors

We are looking for mentors who are

- Professors,
- Research associates who have completed a doctoral degree or habilitation and have extensive experience in academia who are willing to share their knowledge about structures and career pathways with early career researchers.

Mentors

- receive new impulses for their work,
- reflect upon their own career path,

- be prepared to share your personal experience and (informal) knowledge
- be able to take the time to accompany your mentee (according to individual arrangement)
